Thursday Sep 12	<p>We will caravan in our vehicles through the Scenic Badlands National Park stopping for a sack lunch (pack your own) at the Ben Reifel visitor Center. Next the Minuteman Missile National Historic Site. There are 3 stops along I90 for the Missile Site: 1. The Visitor Center, 2. The Launch Control Facility Delta-01 (reservations required), 3. The Delta-09 missile silo.</p> <p>The tours for the Delta-01 Control facility are limited to 6 people. I have already purchased all 6 tickets for the 2:00 Tour. <u>Nevin wants to go and I will give the other 5 tickets away to the FIRST registration forms received where people have expressed an interest in going. The Delta-01 tour is moderately strenuous and requires a quarter mile round trip walk to and from the Delta-01 compound. All tour participants must be able to climb two 15 foot ladders, walk, and stand unassisted. You must be comfortable with heights and small elevators.</u> Visitors will see the living, dining, and recreational areas for the eight people stationed on the topside at Delta-01, working three days on and three days off at a time. Visitors then descend via an elevator 31 feet underground. They enter the Launch Control Center by walking past an eight ton blast door built to protect missile crews from the effects of a nuclear blast. Visitors will see the complicated array of electronics used by missileers during their alert shifts to monitor the missiles and learn what it was like to have the awesome responsibility of thermonuclear war at their fingertips.</p> <p>We will meet up and end our afternoon/evening at Wall, SD. Return to the campground at your leisure. Evening is on your own.</p>	<p>Enter the Badlands National Park Private Vehicle: \$25 - Valid for 7 days.</p> <p>Free for Golden Age Passport or America the Beautiful Card Holders.</p> <p>Get your pass here: https://www.recreation.gov/pass/</p> <p>(Entering the pay station, we will try to pair non card holders in a vehicle with those that have a card.)</p>

Friday Sep 13	Drive to Hot Springs, SD. Two hour bus tour of the Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary . This sanctuary is supported by donations and tourism. The Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary was created to provide and maintain a permanent private home for America's unwanted wild horses. The goal of saving the American Wild Mustang also includes the preservation of endangered wild horse bloodlines of the resident mustang bands. This includes the Spanish, Choctaw Indian, Curly and American Mustangs. They provide a public educational experience of wild horse history and the contribution of the horse to the Native American and European American destines.
